Carousels

Space in the pharmacy is limited. The Omnicell® Pharmacy Carousel uses vertical storage and retrieval technology to consolidate your medication footprint, which saves time during picking and stocking operations. It integrates with Central Pharmacy Manager software to provide comprehensive medication inventory management, improve staff productivity, and help reduce medication errors.

Our refrigerated carousel model offers inventory control and expiration tracking for refrigerated medications and features a redundant refrigeration system to reduce the risk of inventory loss.



Inventory and Workflow Software

Managing medication distribution is a complex process and mistakes can be costly. Central Pharmacy Manager helps control costs and drive efficiency by providing perpetual inventory management throughout the pharmacy, nursing floors, centralized service centers (CSCs), satellite pharmacies, and clinics.

Controlled Substance Management

Regulators continue to scrutinize controlled substance handling to prevent diversion. The XT Controlled Substance Manager automates the management of controlled medications, saving valuable staff time while helping to meet DEA, ISMP, Joint Commission, and other regulatory guidelines.

To protect patient safety and reduce hospital liability, XT Controlled Substance Manager provides full accountability of drug movement – from wholesalers, to the pharmacy and patient care areas, and back to the pharmacy.



High Speed Packagers

The medication repackaging process can be labor-intensive and costly. Omnicell's high speed packagers ease this burden by repackaging bulk oral solids, automating cabinet filling, and filling patient orders, helping to improve productivity and reduce costs. They package up to 60 unit doses per minute in addition to supporting half-tablet and low volume medications. Each unit-dose package is labeled and barcoded to ensure accuracy all the way to the patient bedside.



Central Pharmacy Blister Packager

Though Omnicell's fully automated robot supports native manufacturer packaging, there's often still a need to buy some medications in bulk. The Omnicell Central Pharmacy Blister Packager is a flexible solution capable of filling most oral medications into a variety of unit dose packages while integrating with Central Pharmacy Manager. By enabling your pharmacy technicians to package up to 120 doses per minute, the blister packager helps you achieve significant unit dose packing efficiency.
