OmniSphere is designed to break down silos across the medication use journey, streamline future growth and capability enhancements, and reduce the IT burden on health systems.

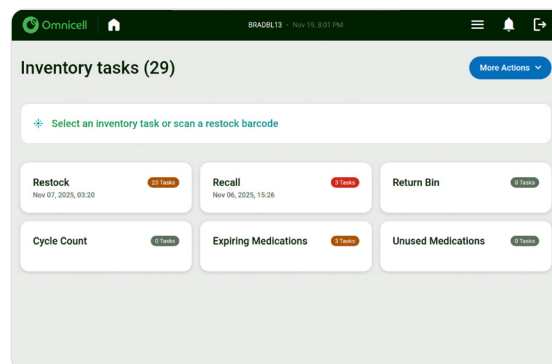

- A platform that upholds industry-leading security and compliance standards with HITRUST certification that is designed to reduce IT risk

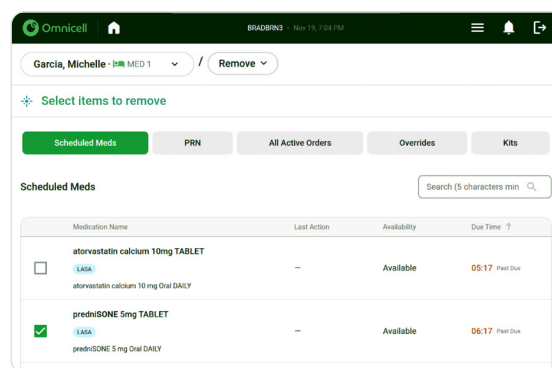
