Closed Loop for Nursing

Advanced integration with Epic and Cerner EHRs enables a real-time Issue vs. Administration report for tracking medications issued and administered, along with wastes and returns.


The loop is closed on a medication order when the reconciliation shows that the amount issued was administered, wasted, or returned, with no outstanding balance. For items that do not balance, filtering options are available to aid in resolving issues.
